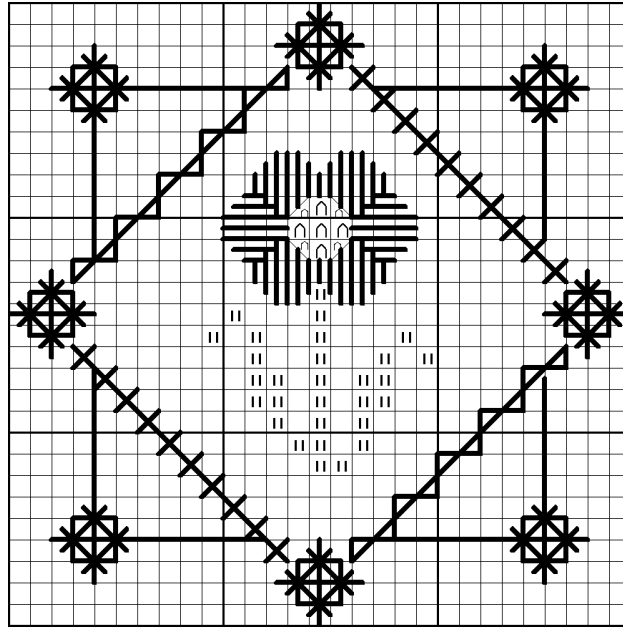


# Bug Collector Scissors Fob



Design Size on 28 ct = 2 x 2 "  
Design Size on 36 ct =  
1 5/8 x 1 5/8 "

## Supplies:

5 X 5" piece of 28 ct. Antique white  
A funky matching piece of fabric for  
backing  
12" of coordinating ribbon  
Sampler Threads (ST):  
Spring Grass  
Hyacinth  
Needle Necessities Overdyed Floss (NN):  
1931 Calypso  
1101 Clearly Blue  
1611 Pot O' gold  
Tapestry needle, needle & thread

## Instructions:

Cross stitch: 2 strands floss  
Backstitch: 1 strand floss  
Refer to stitch diagrams for specialty  
stitches.

Flower: Satin stitch flower head in NN  
Clearly Blue.

Cross stitch flower center in NN Pot O'  
Gold.

Cross stitch stem and leaves in two  
strands of ST Spring Grass.

The four corners are upright cross  
stitched in NN Calypso.

Back stitch with 2 strands of NN Calypso,  
then with ST Hyacinth tie these 2  
strands down with the variety shown.

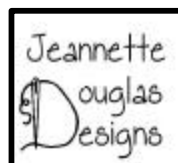
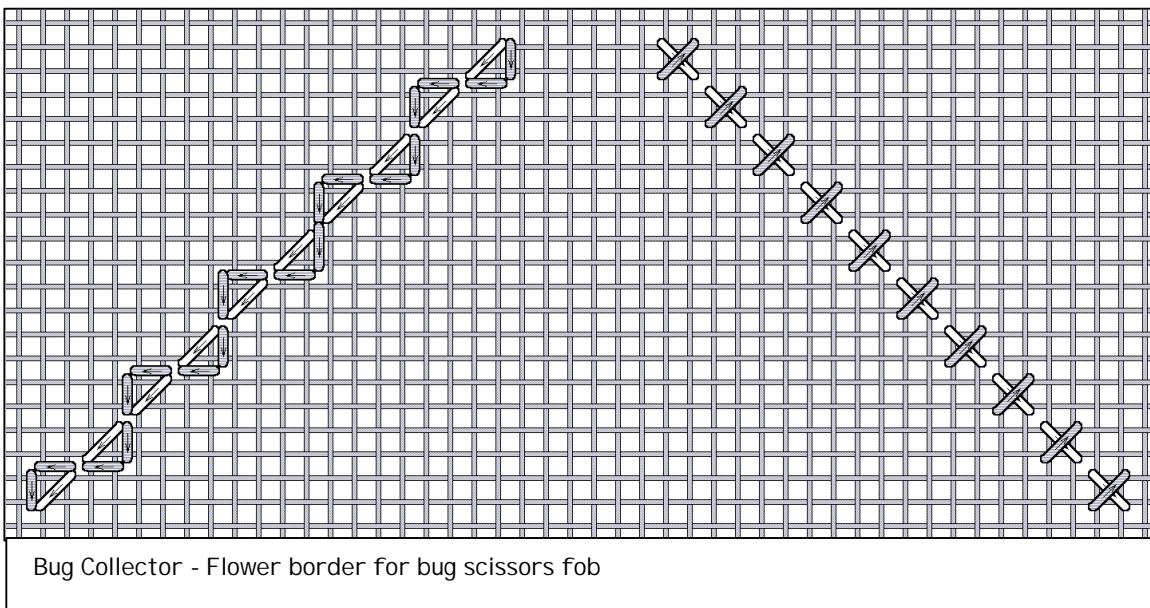
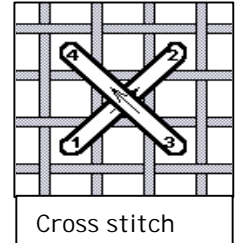
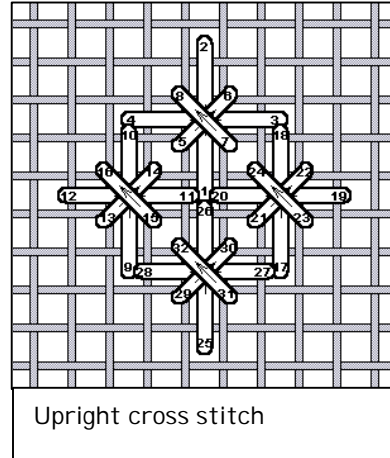
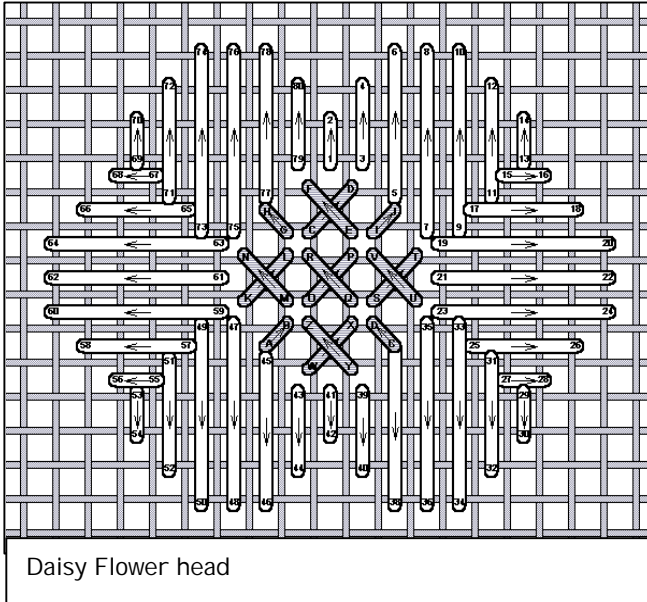
Back stitch the outer straight lines and  
add the four corners of upright stitches  
all in 2 strands NN Calypso.

These back stitches are not tied. Add  
your doodlebug/ ladybug wherever you  
like.

**Finishing:**

Count out 12 threads from each corner point of design and mark this spot. Put right sides of pattern and material together stitching along the counted out 12 threads, leaving a minimum of 1" open at top left-hand end. Cut excess fabric.

Turn right side out. Fold ribbon in half and knot at ends, tuck knot into opening and whip stitch, catching ribbon as you stitch. Leave small opening, fill with rice and continue to whip stitch closed. Loop ribbon through scissors.
